







## Lock & Key Single Vineyard Tumbarumba Pinot Noir 2022

Varieties:	Pinot Noir
Region:	Tumbarumba, NSW
Winemaker notes:	The grapes were cold soaked for two days prior to being inoculated with a cultured yeast. Cool ferment over seven days resulted in deep colour and lifted floral aromatics. Partial maturation in two and three year old French barriques (reclassified from the Crest and Sirius programs to facilitate an early bottling) has contributed more depth and complexity.
TASTING NOTES	
Colour:	Bright purple
Nose:	Beautifully fragrant with lifted cherries and plums, floral aromas and woody undertones
Palate:	Bright and juicy with excellent weight and depth. The palate is vibrant and layered with red currants, raspberries, cherries and subtle spice. Mouth-filling yet still possessing classic Pinot refinement.
Comments:	A remarkably good wine for the money. The focus is firmly on cool climate Pinot characters; elegant and complex
Alcohol:	13%
