## **Crafted** Hilltops Cabernet Sauvignon 2018

Varieties:	Cabernet Sauvignon
Region:	Hilltops NSW
Vintage conditions:	From a single block on the Moppity Vineyard. The 2017 vintage produced fruit with incredible colour and intensity of flavour at low sugar levels. There was a distinct vibrancy in block 2 which was chosen for its pure, bold and crunchy blueberry tones.
Winemaking notes:	Cold soaked for 5 days pre-ferment, 12 day fermentation, barrel aged in new and 1, 2 and 3 year old French hogsheads and barriques for 12 months. Multiple rackings to clarify, aerate and add complexity.

Colour:	Deep red/purple in colour
Nose:	Dark berry fruits, bitter chocolate and minty notes
Palate:	An intense and complex palate of blackcurrant, dark plums, cloves and mint are beautifully integrated with subtle cedar oak. Generous depth and beautifully textured.
