





Moppity Vineyards Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2021

Varieties:	Cabernet Sauvignon
Region:	Hilltops NSW; Moppity Vineyard at 600m (highest elevation in the region). This contributes to the high diurnal temperature range affording us good natural acidity.
Viticultural:	Shoot thinned & leaf thinned with nearly all the fruit coming from our low yielding (1.5 tonnes pa), old vine block.
Winemaking:	Cold soaked pre-ferment, 12 day fermentation, barrel aged in new and used French hogsheads and barriques for 12 months. Multiple rackings to clarify and aerate.
Tasting notes	
Colour:	Deep, dark purple; typical of the Hilltops region
Nose:	A gorgeous nose of ripe dark berries, dried herbs and cedary oak.
Palate:	Generous and stylish, the palate is bright & lifted with lovely complexity. Layered & bright dark fruits merge onto a rich palate that has a seamless structure. Oak notes add to the wines complexity with fine supple tannins supporting the long & flavoursome finish.
Comments:	Significant viticulture improvements in our Cabernets has resulted in 6 Trophies and 12 Gold medals in the last few years.
Alcohol:	14%
