





Moppity Vineyards "Lunam" Riesling 2022

Variety & Clone:	Riesling, Geisenheim clone.
Region:	Canberra Region, Murrumbateman
Labelling notes:	The artwork for this label was painted by the Canberra artist James Manning, a schoolfriend of winemaker Jason Brown. The wine takes its name from the artwork, "Lunam".
Winemaking notes:	After a cool, long ripening vintage less than 0.7 tonne per hectare of Moppity's first Canberra region Riesling was meticulously hand-picked by Jason and Alecia Brown and their four boys. The grapes were chilled, gently pressed and the free run juice was kept chilled for 7 days prior to inoculation and a week long cool ferment. The cool handling ensured freshness and fruit brightness. Finally it was racked off lees and fined with vegan friendly fining. Minimum sulphur was used throughout the winemaking process.
Tasting notes	
Colour:	Pale lemon with green hints.
Nose:	Floral aromas appear alongside mandarin and citrus.
Palate:	Mandarin and lime razor sharp freshness is complemented by some softer floral notes. Finishing bright and clean with a talcy complexity.
Comments:	Only 120 cases of this wine were produced. Drink it now or cellar it for up to 15 years.
