"Atrius" - named after the Atria constellation ("Southern Triangle" - referencing its three brightest stars located in the sky to our south west)

The three most significant cool climate regions in Southern NSW are Canberra, Hilltops and Tumbarumba - its brightest stars with Canberra at its heart.

Region:	Hilltops, NSW
Viticulture:	The '23 vintage was cool, wet and long, resulting in fruit of high intensity. The very light crop was hand picked.
Winemaking:	The fruit was whole bunch pressed and only the free run juice was used. A long cool ferment ensured the retention of aromatics. Minimal sulphur was used. Vegan finings.

Comments:	Hailing from Rias Baixas, Galicia on the northwest coastline, Alberino is Spain's answer to Pinot Gris and is its dominant white variety. The Hilltops region is viticulturally perfect for this variety in Australia. We have grafted it to a single site on our Werrington Vineyard.
