"Atrius" - named after the Atria constellation ("Southern Triangle" - referencing its three brightest stars located in the sky to our south west)

The three most significant cool climate regions in Southern NSW are Canberra, Hilltops and Tumbarumba - its brightest stars with Canberra at its heart.

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Region:	Murrumbateman, Canberra district
Labelling notes:	The artwork for this label was painted by the celebrated Canberra artist James Manning – long time friend of winemaker Jason Brown. The wine takes its name from the artwork, "Lunam".
Winemaking notes:	After a cool, long ripening, low yielding vintage the grapes were hand picked, gently pressed and the free run juice was kept chilled for 7 days prior to inoculation and a week long cool ferment. The cool handling ensured freshness and fruit brightness. Finally it was racked off lees and fined with vegan friendly fining. Minimum sulphur was used throughout the winemaking process.
